Creating Green Jobs in Palm Beach County

Roland Williams, the **American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (CSBG-ARRA)** grant manager is focusing on Green Jobs.

Since receiving ARRA funding in November 2009, we have created 12 Green Jobs with a target of 100 by the end of September. Below is a brief summary of the business we created with our sub-grantee. We made a decision to maximize all our resources and utilize what we have to create a green business. Below is a brief summary of the E-Books business that was launched on January 14, 2010, by Gulfstream Goodwill through the ARRA-GATE program.

The basic concept of E-Books is taking books that are donated to the Goodwill stores and selling them on line at a higher price than they would be sold for at the retail store. We use special computerized scanning equipment to scan the donated books. This scanning process establishes whether a book may be sold through the standard retail stores or through the E-Books department. The special computerized scanner equipment automatically prices the books and lists them on Amazon.com. A customer may purchase a book on line. The donated books are stored by category. When an order is place, the books are easily retrieved for shipping. An on-line purchase will be routed to the warehouse where the books are stored and the shipper/receiver fills the order and ships the books to the purchaser.

The positions attached to this business are: 1 Supervisor; 2 Shipper/Receiver and 4 Pre-Scanners.

As of 2/5/10 there have been 410 books put in the inventory. We have shipped 114 books totaling \$1,179.28 gross revenue. This total represents an average of \$10.35 per transaction.
