Temporary Protective Status Outreach

TPS APPLICATION PREPARATION

The U.S. government has granted Haitians who lived in the U.S. prior to January 12, 2010, Temporary Protective Status (TPS). This means that for 18 months or longer if the program is extended, those who qualify and apply with the 180 days registration window, may be granted TPS and receive an employment card to work. It is important that you apply before July 20, 2010.

WHAT TO BRING: 3 Separate money orders for immigration filing fees:\$50 TPS Application; \$80 Biometric Fee; \$340 for the employment work authorization application; Two pictures passport size; Haitian Passport/Birth Certificate, I-94, or employment card that has expired; Documents that demonstrates that you were in the U.S. before January 12, 2010; Married spouse and children's names, date of birth and addresses.

\$50 fee for preparation of two applications. The preparation fee will be waived for those who prove they meet poverty guidelines.
