FAU Center for Autism and Related Disabilities is leading an initiative to create awareness among the community, educators, and health care providers about the problem of under-representation of Black people in Autism. Research indicates that Black children are being misidentified, delay identified and under-identified with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Without proper identification children will not receive access to evidence-based interventions to progress academically and socially and parents and families will not receive the support and training needed to help their children.
