All public officials in the US are elected by popular vote except two – the President and Vice President. The National Popular Vote means that the President and Vice President would be elected by a majority of all Americans without regard to which state they live in, making this consistent with elections for all other US public officials. Contrary to what many people think, no Constitutional amendment is needed to make this happen.
