Paper Tigers follows a year in the life of the Lincoln High Alternative School in Walla Walla, Washington. The school has become a promising model of how to break the cycles of poverty, violence, and disease that affect families through the practice of traumainformed educational strategies, and is a testament to what the latest research on childhood adversity is proving: that one caring adult can change the trajectory of a young person's life.
