



Bipartisan Workforce Legislation Becomes Law

The bipartisan supported workforce legislation signed into law will transform the way Floridians get a job, pursue job training, and prepare themselves for future careers. The new law ensures alignment between Florida's education and workforce needs by promoting career readiness and workforce opportunities for students and working adults. This new central system will make



it easier for consumers to access services and career planning, and register for job training. Students will be provided with career planning resources as they progress along their educational experience so they are

aware of different options available to them. The law establishes the "Florida Pathways to Career Opportunities Grant Program", which provides competitive grants to eligible institutions to create or expand apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship programs. It also establishes the "Last Mile Scholarship," that will pay for eligible individuals to finish their first associate or baccalaureate degree. For a list of the law's highlights, click **HERE**.
