For the 2022-2023 grant cycle, projects/organizations addressing reproductive rights, housing insecurity, and affordable childcare will be given priority.
- Herizon will provide general support funding, but only to organizations whose overall mission is explicitly focused on the topics mentioned above.
- Our grant cycle is open to any registered 501(c)3 in the US who meets the criteria listed in our grant guidelines; Israeli organizations must be formally invited to apply.
