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Air Conditioning (HVAC) Replacement Program for Homeowners Assistance Deadline Extended

The Crisis Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Replacement Program, through LIHEAP (Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program), is working to assist low-income, Palm Beach County homeowners in need of replacing their home's HVAC system, with assistance up to \$15,000. The money can be used to replace home cooling systems.

Clients must be income eligible and live in Palm Beach County. Completed applications must show one or more of the following:

- Must reside in Palm Beach County and own their home
- Must meet income eligibility requirements
- Must document a crisis, such as:
 - An inoperable HVAC system that no longer heats or cools
 - An HVAC unit that is at least 7 years old (with proof of high energy bills)
 - A medical need for a controlled environment (with documentation from a physician)

All applications must be received by June 16, 2025 to ensure all work is completed in a timely manner.
