NEW: Food Finder Map

On a typical day in Palm Beach County, more than 185,000 residents do not know where their next meal will come from. That number has dramatically increased due to the economic impacts of the coronavirus.

As the leader of the community-wide Hunger Relief Plan, the United Way team is working to connect food pantries and resources to effectively feed more people all across the county. **This week, we launched a Food Finder map - an interactive tool using Google Maps to help people easily locate free food and hot meals in Palm Beach County.**

This map was created in partnership with Palm Beach County, the School District of Palm Beach County, Palm Beach County Food Bank, Feeding South Florida, FLIPANY, Boys and Girls Clubs of Palm Beach County, Area Agency on Aging Palm Beach/Treasure Coast, Healthy Mothers Healthy Babies, Living Hungry, and Hospitality Helpings Hands.
