CareerSource Palm Beach County Centers Closed Nov. 9 – 11; Paychecks for Patriots Job Fair Rescheduled for Nov. 14

West Palm Beach, Fla. (Nov. 8, 2022) – CareerSource Palm Beach County facilities will be closed Wednesday, Nov. 9 and Thursday, Nov. 10 due to storm conditions and Friday, Nov. 11 in observance of Veterans Day.

The Paychecks for Patriots job fair has been rescheduled for Monday, Nov. 14 at the Hilton Palm Beach Airport, 150 Australian Ave., West Palm Beach, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. In addition to connecting veterans and their spouses with 60 local and national employers along with support services, Paychecks for Patriots is open to all job seekers as well. Professional headshots and LinkedIn reviews will be offered at no cost between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.

Employers participating in the job fair include NextEra Energy/Florida Power & Light Co., Amazon, FedEx, Palm Beach County HR, Amazon, DSS Inc., Jupiter Medical Center, Allied Universal, Eau Palm Beach, Fifth Third Bank, Nova Southeastern University, and more. There is no charge to participate, but job seekers should register at this link for express entry instead of having to do so upon arrival:

- Veterans on our staff who know how to effectively connect your military experience and skills with prospective civilian employers
