### 2021-2022 Food Storage Capacity Grant - Round Two

**Application closing date has been extended to  
July 6, 2022 at 11:59 p.m.**

United Way of Palm Beach County's (UWPBC) Hunger Relief Initiative Food Storage Capacity Grant (FSCG) - Round Two is now open! The goal of the FSCG is to expand food storage capacity in order to minimize food waste and increase the volume of nutritious food available throughout the hunger relief system in Palm Beach County (PBC).

Interested food providers must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Applicants must be a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that provides hunger relief services in Palm Beach County.
- Applicants must be able to upload tax exemption information.
- Applicants must have completed a food safety training course.
- Applicants must be an active partner in good standing with 211 Palm Beach/Treasure Coast or provide an explanation of exemption.
- Applicant must have an active partnership with a food bank/food provider or be a food provider.
