With Master's Degree, a minimum of four years of child welfare experience with emphasis on child development for children birth to five years with a minimum one year supervisory and operations experience. With Bachelor's degree, a minimum of eight years of child welfare experience with a minimum of three years of child development for children birth to five years. Minimum one year experience working with developmental screenings, assessment tools, and processes required. **BILINGUAL ENGLISH / CREOLE REQUIRED.** Valid FL driver's license with clean driving record is required.
