### Program Description:

An engaging course that provides community leaders an overview of our WYSM training system for both peace officers and for the community. This program provides real-life tools & communication techniques that enhance safety & help both community members and law enforcement professionals to recognize the value of **seeking to better understand one another while embracing diversity, equity, inclusion, and belonging.**

During this training, Community leaders will learn concepts to help understand why the “cops” do what they do during law enforcement interactions with the public. Discussions will be had on what works (from both sides) and what doesn't work (from both sides). Created by Long Beach Police Sergeant (ret.) Jason Lehman and community leaders, this course (which is facilitated by a team of law enforcement & community leaders), incorporates thought-stimulating discussions and personal perspectives (of both “cooperative” and “difficult” members of both law enforcement and the public). Our scenario-based exercises will challenge the status quo & engage participants for effective learning & leadership development. **This training shows us that even the best must get better if we are to see a healthier and safer community.**

### Course Objectives:

- Understand training systems currently trained to deputies/officers in your neighborhood
- Discuss why deputies/officers do what they do while better understanding procedures
- Comprehend how “community partnerships” improve safety
- Build trust in the reporting systems of misconduct
- Discuss the triggers of rage and improve “emotional state” during response (E+R=O)
- Improve upon “Best Practice” communication and relationship-building techniques
- Learn to better answer your “why” as a leader and advocate for peace
- Q and A session with Team WYSM and member(s) of the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office
