You have to register with a Vocational Rehabilitation counselor and request a referral to the CILO career camps you want. To find a VR counselor near you see the phone numbers below. Your children will earn up to \$500 per camp based on a simple evaluation by our teachers. They will be paid from our funds about 30 days after the last day of camp, like they always have been paid.

This is not new. VR does not pay us for months, so we have to use our funds. My suggestion is don't mention payments to VR. They correctly focus on what is best you for child to learn and don't want financial rewards to interfere.

Email or call your Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) counselor **today to request all of your referrals. **See VR phone numbers below.** Mention that our ID is VR650174695004.**

If you need help finding a counselor or if you still have questions after receiving our phone calls and texts, please call Dan at 561-398-2828.

Tell your counselor whether you want virtual or in-person camp. Virtual is easier to get into and you avoid rides back and forth.

To allow students to focus on lessons, mobile phones, and other electronic devices can be used only on designated breaks.

Tips to get your referral:

1 -- Haven't heard back from VR counselor? Some counselors have taken other jobs. If you don't get an email reply call the main office for your city/county listed below. Start by telling them where you live to ensure you have the correct office. **Email me if you are having problems getting a referral. dan@cilo.org**

2 -- Most of our classes are virtual, but we have a limited number of in-person seats at United Methodist Church, 900 Brandywine Rd., WPB 33409 **Consider virtual please, in-person fills up fast.**

4 -- Can't remember your counselor's name? Try searching in your email for vr.fldoe.org, and their email should come up.

NOTE: We understand that school district schedules vary from county to county and expect students to attend only as their schedules allow, even if this means some students may not be able to attend camp on all of the scheduled dates. To qualify for the minimum hourly payment, the student will have to complete at least 10 hours of camp.

***REMINDER:** CILO is not able to offer 1-on-1 or paraprofessional services. Students who require 1-on-1 assistance at school, or for eating or going to the bathroom, are not eligible for camp. All Students attending our camps must be able to participate in a group setting, with up to 10 students per group, without causing a distraction for teachers or other students.
