Prepares intake reports, psychosocial summaries, genograms, treatment plans; maintains case notes using a computerized database. Provides task supervision to Youth and Family Counseling students/interns involved in field placements. Interacts with schools/social service agencies/other professionals in order to provide client services as needed and to educate the public on Youth/Family Counseling services and the Youth Services Department.
