Council Update: Council approves \$500,000 for COVID-19 grants for nonprofits

At an emergency council meeting this week, Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County's board approved the use of up to \$500,000 for a contingency fund to support nonprofits working to meet the needs of local families. The Council's contingency fund, and dollars dedicated by seven other partners, will be distributed by each organization through the COVID-19 Relief & Recovery Grant process. The Council's funding has been earmarked for food, basic needs (excluding shelter), and direct services to children and families. Funding also was made available to help meet the increased demands on the 2-1-1 Helpline, which has seen its call volume more than double during the crisis. [Click here](#) to read more.
