\$29 Million Plan for Rural Communities

This week, the Governor announced \$29 million in development grants for 42 small and rural communities. Funding will go to unincorporated cities with less than 200,000 people and cities with populations under 50,000 people with low-income/moderate income. The purpose of this plan is to boost employment in these areas through investment in workforce and infrastructure. This plan is important because it will shift the focus from only investing in urban and populated areas to small municipalities that need the help to improve their economies. These funds will be available through the Department of Economic Opportunity from its program, Florida Small Cities Community Development Block Grant.
