Special Session on the Week of May 17th

President Simpson and Speaker Sprowls have issued a call for special session for the purpose of considering legislation that would ratify the 2021 Gaming Compact between the Seminole Tribe of Florida and the State of Florida, as well as other gaming-related legislation. This Gaming Compact will have an important impact on the State's economy. This agreement between the State of Florida and the Seminole Tribe of Florida will generate the state a minimum of \$2.5 billion in new revenue over the next five years and an estimated \$6 billion through 2030. Special Session is scheduled May 17-21, 2021.
