Clerk Employees Bring Joy to Seniors This Holiday Season



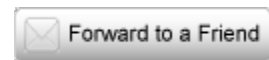
Clerk employees donated more than 80 trees to MorseLife.

Employees with the Clerk & Comptroller, Palm Beach County donated 86 decorated holiday trees to seniors in need this holiday season.

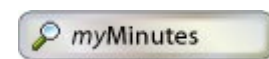
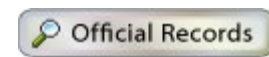
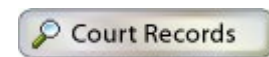
