All Floridians 18 and Older are now Eligible for COVID-19 Vaccine

Governor Ron DeSantis announced starting on Monday, April 5, 2021, vaccines will open up to "all individuals age 18 and older." Floridians are encouraged to pre-register for the vaccine on a state-operated website by **clicking here**. You'll then be contacted when a vaccine appointment is available in your area.

You can currently receive the COVID-19 vaccine in Florida at Publix, CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Sam's Club and Winn-Dixie pharmacies, as well as county and state-run sites.
