

The Emergency HVAC Replacement Initiative, under the umbrella of the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), is designed to support qualifying homeowners in Palm Beach County who need to upgrade their home's air-conditioning units, offering up to \$15,000 in aid.

To be eligible, applicants should:

- Have a qualifying income level.
- Reside in Palm Beach County.
- Demonstrate a pressing need.

Applicants should present:

- Proof of home ownership in a residence they live in.
- Evidence that the HVAC system isn't functioning properly.
- An HVAC system that's a decade old or older.
- High utility bill statements.
- A doctor's note indicating a health risk without adequate air conditioning.

So far, over 250 households have benefited from this initiative in updating their HVAC systems.
