Healthy Mothers, Healthy Babies  
has a Basics4Babies emergency pantry  
that provides formula, infant food and  
other basic needs for babies  
from birth to 12 months?

Diapers are also available for children  
from birth through age 3.

Basics4Babies supports families in our  
community with these items based  
on emergency need:

- ▶ Diapers for sizes newborn to 6  
(maximum of 1 visit every 30 days)\*
- ▶ One week's worth of formula for infants 0-12 months  
(maximum of 6 visits up to the baby's 1st birthday)\*
- ▶ One week's worth of baby food for infants 6-12 months
- ▶ Additional basic needs including bottles, wipes,  
baby clothes and blankets\*
- ▶ Information on other service agencies in our  
community that families may need

\*Based on inventory.



### Eligibility:

- Baby being served must live in  
Palm Beach County.
- Photo ID of the parent/caregiver is required.
- Appointed guardian must provide legal  
documentation of custodianship.
- New clients must present birth certificate of the  
child or discharge paperwork from the hospital.
