No automated systems, no unreturned calls; instead, interested foster parents will receive the first-class service and support they deserve. With nearly 23,000 children in foster care, and the state's and faith and community organizations' constant desire to raise up new foster parents, it was imperative that we made sure our front door was open!

Through a partnership with the national foster care and adoption non-profit Angel Armies Foundation and their five national, best-in-class non-profit partners, we are offering all faith institutions in Florida a menu of FREE options to establish or deepen your journey in supporting children and families in foster care within your communities. We believe that not everyone is called to foster or adopt, but we are all called to do something, so we have given the below menu options as ways for faith institutions to be involved.

Menu options include:

- Using a mobile application to see real time needs of children and families in crisis in your area (like delivering meals to new foster and adoptive families).
- Sharing images and messages in your organization's correspondence to bring awareness to the foster care needs and the MyFloridaMyFamily website.
- Helping children experiencing trauma to cope with their experiences.
- Hosting seminars for biological parents while their children are in foster care.
- Identifying the foster parents (domestic missionaries) in your faith institution and delivering wrap-around care.
- Assistance with becoming a foster and adoptive friendly church by receiving prepackaged sermon outlines, small group materials, and class curriculum.
- Receiving material that can help you promote Florida's Foster Information Center at your faith institution.
