



## **Municipal Elections & Vote by Mail Ballot Requests**

- Municipalities will be holding local elections on March 11, 2025.
- All requests for Vote-by-Mail ballots from prior elections have EXPIRED!
- If you want to vote by mail in these elections, or any elections through 2026, you must file a new request for a Vote-by-Mail ballot.

The easiest way for Palm Beach County voters to reapply for a Vote-by-Mail ballot is to call the Supervisor of Elections at **561-656-6200**.

You can also request a Vote-by-Mail ballot at [this link](#) on the Supervisor of Elections (SOE) website. While on the website, you can sign up for BALLOTTRAX, a system which will notify you when your ballot is mailed to you, when it is received at the SOE office, and when it is counted.

We strongly recommend that you check your Voter Status at the SOE website to make sure it is accurate, that you have not been mistakenly dropped, and that your Vote-by-Mail request is valid if you have already applied for it.
