 - Unidad de aire acondicionado es de al menos 10 años (debe mostrar facturas altas del servicio de energía), o
 - El cliente requiere un ambiente controlado debido a una condición de salud (debe mostrar prueba de un caso que amenaza la vida, documentado por el médico del cliente)
