Are you a taxpayer 65+ and missed the #IRS tax deadline? File now! You may be eligible for an extra \$6,000 tax deduction. Check if you qualify: www.irs.gov/obbb

Are you 65 or older? From 2025 through 2028, a new tax deduction could help lower your tax bill. Even if you missed the #IRS deadline remember: Eligible seniors may claim an additional \$6,000. Learn more: www.irs.gov/obbb

A new senior deduction under the One, Big, Beautiful Bill puts more money in older Americans' pockets. Even if you missed the #IRS deadline, file your return and check whether you qualify for this tax deduction: www.irs.gov/obbb

There are no income requirements to establish a Trump Account, and everyone is eligible as long as the child is a U.S. citizen and both parents have Social Security numbers. And it's easy to set up one of these tax-deferred savings accounts at: TrumpAccounts.gov

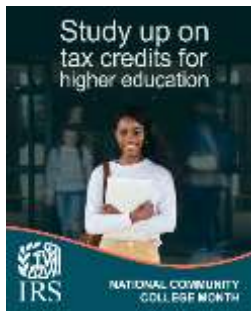
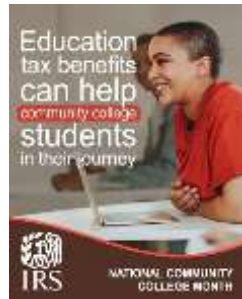
Signing up your children for Trump Accounts is quick and easy. You can use #IRS Form 4547, or register online on: TrumpAccounts.gov
