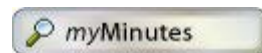
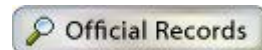
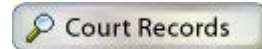

In recognition of National Guardianship Month this October, Clerk Bock is encouraging her team of nearly 700 employees to donate to Gulfstream Goodwill Industries' audiology services program.

Hearing loss affects millions of elderly adults, impacting their ability to effectively communicate with others. Unfortunately, elders who suffer from undiagnosed hearing loss can be subject to court determinations of incapacity, and possibly placed under an unnecessary guardianship.

Through Clerk Bock's [Clerks for a Cause program](#), employees can make a \$10 payroll donation to Gulfstream Goodwill's program, which provides free audiologist services, hearing aids, cleanings, tube replacements and hearing tests to qualified individuals over 60 years old. In exchange, Clerk employees can dress down at work every Wednesday during October's National Guardianship Month.
