2nd Quarter 2020 Financial Report

Second quarter of our fiscal year 2020 (July 1, 2020 thru September 30, 2020) performance remained strong for LWVPBC and our Education Fund, despite of the effect of the Covid-19 pandemic. Through texting, social media and Zoom presentations we were able reach out to members and the community at large. Continued generous donations from members and others kept us financially sound and active.

As you can see from the charts, consolidated income and expenses for LWVPBC and the Education Fund, while below budget, resulted in Net Income of \$29,801 for the 6 month period. Operating expense and income decreased dramatically as we held no in person lunches or events. We greatly increased our outreach via online communications to compensate, and held effective Census outreach and voter education, information, and get out the vote campaigns. These initiatives reached out to low turnout voters and to minority communities including Spanish and Creole speaking via texting, social media and PSAs.

- Overall, donations from members, organizations, and sponsors in support of the League's various causes accounted for 68% or \$84,765 of reported \$124,185 in Gross Income for the period.

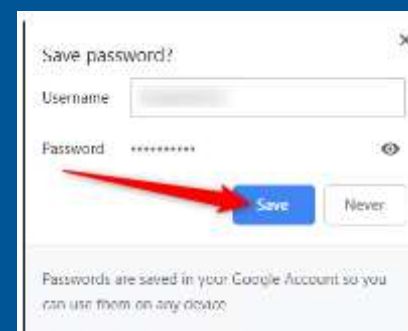
