PALM BEACH COUNTY, FL – Today, September 23rd, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office mailed Vote-by-Mail ballots to international and overseas voters who requested a mail ballot and are eligible to vote in the November 8, 2022 General Election. Mail ballots to stateside and domestic voters are scheduled to begin mailing on September 30, 2022.

Registered voters in Palm Beach County may request a Vote-by-Mail ballot online at <u>VotePalmBeach.gov</u>, email <u>votebymail@votepalmbeach.gov</u>, or call (561) 656-6208. Voters should have their Driver License, Florida ID card, or the last four digits of their Social Security number available when making the request.

The deadline to request that a Vote-by-Mail ballot be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 29, 2022. Our Main Elections Office will be open that Saturday to serve voters. A mail ballot may also be picked up in person at one of our four offices until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 7, 2022. Under emergency circumstances, your ballot may be picked up in person on Election Day.

Voters can return their Vote-by-Mail ballot using pre-paid postage, or drop it off inside any of our four offices during business hours.
