

<u>COVID-19 Mental Health Crisis; Catholic Charities Rising to meet</u> the Need

(Palm Beach Gardens, FL) October 5, 2020 – Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Palm Beach is pleased to announce our new partnership with the Southeast Behavioral Health Network (SEFBHN) as of outpatient mental health services. SEFBHN is the managing entity for the Florida Department of Children and Families tasked with meeting the specific behavioral health needs in the Counties of Indian River, Okeechobee, St. Lucie, Martin, and Palm Beach. This partnership has resulted in a \$150,000 10 month contract to provide no-cost mental health counseling to adults and children negatively impacted by COVID-19 within all five counties covered by SEFBHN. Counseling sessions are available via telehealth video session during pandemic the COVID-19 and in-person at any of Catholic Charities' seven counseling office locations in Ft. Pierce, Stuart, Pahokee, Riviera Beach, Boynton Beach, Palm Beach, and Boca Raton. Catholic Charities counseling services help improve mental wellness and improve functioning for vulnerable populations such as adults and children with fragile mental health, traumatic experiences, and diagnosed mental health conditions.
