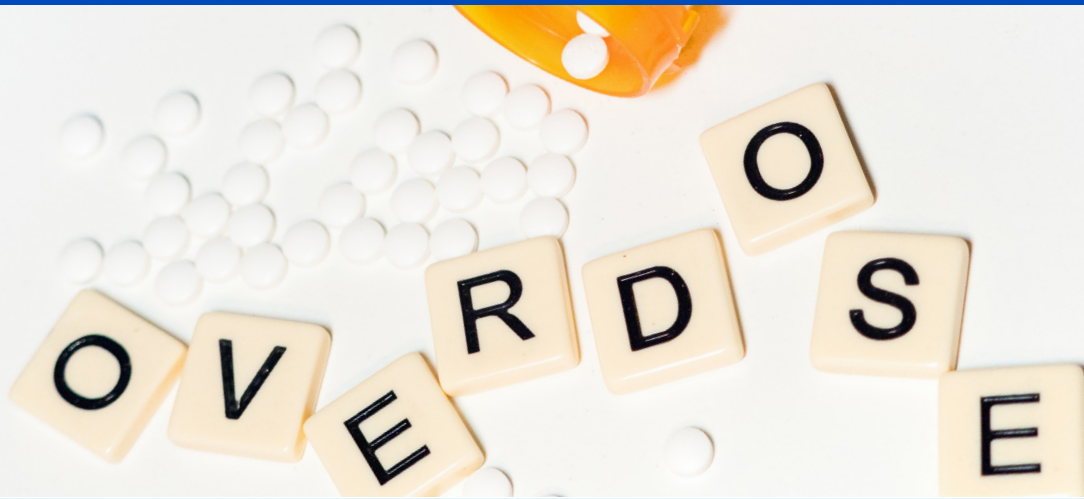


OPIOID ABUSE AFFECTS THE ENTIRE FAMILY. YOU ARE NOT ALONE!
