Molodi: An Experiment in Body Percussion is coming to the Dolly Hand Cultural Arts Center on Friday, May 4! This step-type show features a performance ensemble that uses only their bodies as instruments, taking body percussion to the extreme. Consisting of artists from Stomp, Cirque du Soleil, Step Afrika! and Stomp the Yard, their unique blend of collegiate stepping, gumboots, beatbox, poetry, hip hop dance, guerilla theatre and robust personalities bring to life a high-energy, immersive experience. Dynamic performances, poetic interludes, innovative beat-box/DJ fusions, introspective views on culture and comedic views on cooking and Shakespeare sample the variety of pieces interwoven in this interactive, eclectic and often striking production. The finale drives home the intricate rhythms and precise choreography of this highly-skilled troupe, leaving audiences saying “Gimme some Mo!”

Molodi has traveled the world gleaning from rich cultures and performing with other world-class artists. In the summer of 2015, Molodi joined the creative collaboration to choreograph and perform at the closing ceremonies of the European Games in Baku, Azerbaijan. Molodi has been invited to perform and teach at the International Body Music Festival on several occasions including the 7th and 8th Annual IBMF in Bali, Indonesia and Paris, France, respectively. In addition to performing on the world stage, Molodi holds home, Las Vegas, close to heart performing locally and teaching through their arts in education program, Molodi Unplugged. Working with such organizations as Cirque du Soleil, The Smith Center, Broadway In The Hood and Project 150, Molodi serves the community and continues to enrich lives by inspiring the artist in each of us!
