The event will take place at Vista Center on July 25 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in Conference Room 1W 47/50. Vista Center is located at 2300 N. Jog Road, West Palm Beach.

During this session, HHA representatives will report progress on Palm Beach County's Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness and galvanize stakeholders around short-term goals to end chronic and homelessness among veterans by the end of 2018. HHA representatives will also discuss the plan to place 100 homeless youth ages 18-24 in housing within 100 days, strategies to increase affordable housing units to assist our homeless population and prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless, and methods for building a more efficient homeless services system.
