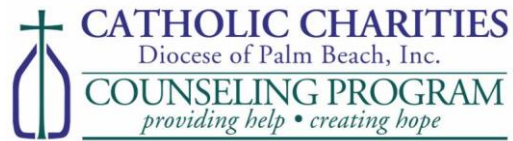

Dear Catholic Charities Supporter:

Our Counseling Program provides access to high quality mental health services for adults, children, families, and couples. Services are provided through telehealth/video and at 7 locations to include Riviera Beach, Palm Beach, Boca Raton, Boynton Beach, Pahokee, Stuart, and Ft. Pierce.

Catholic Charities and our Counseling Program suffered great losses due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Among those losses, was the need to cancel the program's annual 5K Glow Run fundraiser held in the fall, which you previously supported. Proceeds from this event helped pay for counseling services to vulnerable populations who would otherwise not be able to afford it.

In spite of these program losses, our mental health services are needed now more than ever due to the effects of the social isolation from COVID-19 has on individuals and families plagued with underlying mental health issues. We quickly adjusted to the need, and transitioned our counseling sessions online, through a tele-health platform. Even in those cases where someone must isolate at home and for those with no transportation, we can provide our mental health services through video sessions.
