We are pleased to announce Cycle 2 of our Tau Grant Program officially opens **Tuesday, January 7, 2025**. Tau Grants offer unrestricted general operating support for organizations that provide services to the following marginalized groups: BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color), LGBTQ+, Individuals with disabilities, and/or other historically disenfranchised groups.

Additionally, we are interested in nonprofit organizations working in one or more of the following areas:

Access to Healthcare

Healthcare access is the ability to obtain healthcare services such as diagnosis, prevention or treatment that's affordable and convenient.

Economic Mobility

Economic mobility is the ability of individuals to improve themselves and their families' economic condition.

Basic Needs

Basic needs are the essential material requirements for daily life and include food, shelter, clothing, hygiene items, transportation, and access to information.

Eligibility

To be considered for funding the organization must meet all of the following requirements:



- The organization has an **operating budget of less than \$1 million.**
- Serves residents in one or more of the following counties: Miami-Dade, Palm Beach, St. Lucie, Martin, Hillsborough, and Pinellas.
- The organization does not have an active (current) Tau Grant.
- At least 50% of the organization's population served falls within the following marginalized groups: BIPOC, LGBTQ+, Individuals with disabilities, and/or Other historically disenfranchised groups.
- At least 25% of staff leadership (leadership as you define it) includes includes individuals who identify as BIPOC, LGBTQ+, Individuals with disabilities, and/or Other historically disenfranchised groups.
- Have received a ruling from the Internal Revenue Service confirming its exemption from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

- Be willing and able to comply with all requirements of the Allegany Franciscan Ministries [Grant Agreement](#).

Individual Tau Grants will be for a two-year term and may total up to \$20,000.
