I wanted to share with you the below information on our current office/staff policy as well as an **invite for a Telephone Town Hall, Thursday, March 19th starting at 6:45PM. The CDC has emphasized the need to take personal responsibility to prevent community spread of COVID-19, with measures such as limiting large gatherings, decreasing social contacts, and practicing personal protective measures. These actions will lower the risk of spreading the virus to individuals who are considered most at risk and reduce the potential strain to healthcare systems. To help protect the community, Rep. Frankel's district events will take place as telephone town halls and telephone meetings until further notice. She will be monitoring and providing further guidance as needed.
