Signs that your child should see a psychiatrist include sleep disturbances, mood instability, an increased desire to be isolated, irritability, clinginess, social withdrawal, and changes in eating habits.

Children benefit from seeing a psychiatrist if they have a mental health condition and are exhibiting behavioral health concerns or issues.
