**This workshop will explore the science, theory, and interplay between trauma, toxic stress, and brain development.**



The latest research on the impact of violence and trauma on brain development will be explored, including Polyvagal Theory, Interpersonal Neurobiology, the Neurobiology of Play, and the impact on Executive Functioning.

Workshop participants will learn effective interventions for healing trauma and creating buffering relationships for children that promote resilience, empathy, executive functioning, and self-regulation.

**Part I: 9:am - 12:00pm** *Impact of Toxic Stress and Violence on Brain Development*

Adverse environments resulting from neglect, abuse, and/or violence may expose children to toxic stress, which disrupts brain architecture and impairs the development of executive function. These skills are critical for learning and development and enable positive behavior, allowing us to make healthy choices.

**Part II: 1:00pm - 4:00pm** *Building Skills that Strengthen Executive Functioning and Self-Regulation*

Executive function and self-regulation skills are the mental processes that enable us to plan, focus attention, remember instructions, and juggle multiple tasks successfully. Children aren't born with these skills and have the potential to develop them.
