Good Afternoon HHA Membership,

It's that time of year again and we need your help, time for the Point- In-Time (PIT) Count. The count involves literally, physically patrolling specific geographic areas in

Palm Beach County and counting our homeless friends while conducting a brief survey.

To cover all of Palm Beach County, it takes several hundred volunteers every year. Volunteers work in teams that each have an experienced team lead who can answer any questions and ensure the evening is a success. There are police escorts that are specifically assigned to help outreach workers conduct their survey.

Volunteers must all go through online training which is available on the registration link. Some of our volunteers were once homeless themselves. We encourage you to forward this information to your networks so we can maximize the number of people with lived experience who will be volunteering. We are requesting volunteers register for a minimum of four hours but welcome additional time if they are able. We will be adapting additional safety measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

All HHA member organizations are required to participate in the PIT Count so please share this information with your staff and your organization's volunteer base to maximize our efforts. Please follow the link on the flyer to register volunteers, register for training and to get additional information.
