The <u>Virtual Summer Breakspot Fun! Camp</u> website is now live! The virtual Camp can be accessed from June 21 – August 6, 2021.

United Way of Palm Beach County (UWPBC) developed a comprehensive *Virtual Summer BreakSpot Fun! Camp* for children who are not participating in summer camps in person and as a resource for camp counselors. Kids of all ages can participate in virtual activities Monday - Friday (available all day) as they enjoy their nutritious summer meal. Attached is a summer schedule for camp counselors. It provides a link to the day's activity so counselors can prepare ahead of time.

The virtual summer camp offers read along to popular children's books, exercise activities, nutrition education, safety videos (i.e., fire, internet, financial, personal safety), and STEM science. Learning is reinforced with activities when possible. Below is a description of the daily themes.

- Monday Reading is Fun (Read along to popular children's books in English every Monday. Read along in Spanish and Haitian Creole every other week)
- Tuesday Exercise is Fun
- Wednesday Healthy Habits are Fun (Nutrition Education)
- Thursday Safety is Fun (Topics include fire, water, personal, internet, and financial safety)
- Friday STEM Science is Fun (NASA-led STEM science projects)

In addition, we encourage children (8 – 12 years old) to participate in a **writing contest** for a chance to have their story turned into an animated video and shown on the last Monday of summer break (August 2)!
