





JUNE CAREER PANEL RECAP

An incredible community of committed education champions led our students in panel-style discussions last month. Professionals in Journalism and Engineering fields provided candid insight into their personal career and college journeys.

Our guest journalists brought vivacious and relevant commentary around current events which certainly inspired and allowed students to feel safe and heard in their own thoughts. From a student: "There are so many more elements to writing stories like Wilkine explained. You need to know your audience, make sure that you have good storytelling elements and a good editor, as well." After hearing from these professionals, 54.5% of the fellows reported having an interest in exploring journalism as a career path.



Although many of our students have aspirations to join the field, **prior to the engineering panel**, **76.2% of the students surveyed reported not knowing anyone within their social circle who is an engineer and after the panel**, **35% more students are interested in exploring this career further.** Luckily our guest engineers provided a boost of encouragement for women and minorities to continue pursuing professions in traditionally male-dominated career fields.

These discussions expose students to the broad options of careers available to them and allow them to truly visualize themselves in a unique and exciting career! We are so grateful to each of the professionals that took the time to sit and share with us!


