**On November 17, 1911, three Howard University undergraduate students, with the assistance of their faculty adviser, gave birth to the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity. This event occurred in the office of biology Professor Ernest E. Just, the faculty adviser, in the Science Hall (now known as Thirkield Hall). The three liberal arts students were Edgar A. Love, Oscar J. Cooper and Frank Coleman. From the initials of the Greek phrase meaning "friendship is essential to the soul," the name Omega Psi Phi was derived. The phrase was selected as the motto. Manhood, Scholarship, Perseverance and Uplift were adopted as cardinal principles.**

**As the largest district comprising of Alabama, Georgia, Florida, and Mississippi, the seventh district through the years has been one of the great standard bearers in the fraternity. The ideas of the Lampados Club, the Leadership Conference, an inspector general, data-based mechanization for membership, a modernized registration process with photos on identification badges, state organizations, and utilization of CD in lieu of paper reports originated in the seventh district.**

**On March 27, 2020, Brother Reginald Harris was elected as the 24<sup>th</sup> Seventh District Representative. During the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, District Representative Harris created the first Virtual District Conference. In addition, the 7<sup>th</sup> District leads the way in advancing health initiatives under the direction of Dr. Kevin Pruitt, Chairman of the 7<sup>th</sup> District Medical and Health Initiatives. Through its health initiative programs, the 7<sup>th</sup> District presents informative webinars and distributes medical literature to its members.**
